A Migrant Story



Li Jun and his little brother.

ere is a family made up of five people – two grandparents, two children and the father of the children. The mother left the family three years ago and is probably now married again. The father has just changed jobs and has a temporary one in construction. If he has work he can get 100 rmb a day.

Li Jun and his younger brother live with the grandmother in Shanghai. The grandfather is in the home village working on the farm. Every year for one month the grandmother takes the two children home to the village to help the grandfather harvest the produce.

Li Jun has a medical condition whereby he has not grown normally and needs to take hormones. He also has some problem with his genitals that require surgery. He needs multiple surgeries and has already had three lots over a couple of years. One surgery remains to be done.

Every month the boy needs about 2,500 rmb for hormone therapy. He has already been having this treatment for six months. Up to now, given his medical condition and the fact of little money, he has normally stayed at home. But this year You Dao started to help him to go to Feng Xian Xiao Tong Xing Kindergarten. He is presently in the third grade. Now

that Li Jun can socialize with other children he has become more open. Recently the You Dao staff went to visit his house and found that he has grown considerably over the past six months and he has a smile on his face.

The Kindergarten, knowing the help that YD is giving, returned one month school fee to the family when they returned home for the harvest to help towards the hormone treatment.





Personal Hygiene 19th September

On 17th October 2012 under the Junior Achievement Program, 10 volunteers from Philips went to Malu Cang Chang Elementary School for a special activity.

129 students were involved in creating their ideal city. With hands and minds, pictures and media, they created a plan for this city. It met the needs of the inhabitants and creatively sought suitable structures with hospitals and schools and governments buildings. Everything was put in order and the children found their own place in the city.

In the area there are many people from Anhui, Sichuan and Guizhou Provinces and an estimated 400 migrant children live in the immediate vicinity.
