The number of migrant workers in Shanghai is about 7.127 million (Sixth national census 2010).

## YOU DAO A Way to Walk and Grow With Migrant Workers and Their Families



You Dao was founded in 2005 with the vision of raising awareness about social responsibility; building alliances and partnerships; supporting and helping migrant workers and their families, as we walk and grow with them.



### “Family Centre Project”

Since early 2010, You Dao has operated a migrant activity center in Feng Xian which provides facilities and support for migrant peoples of various ages. We coordinate volunteers and students who are involved in our work to provide arts and crafts, singing, English conversation and other extra-curricular activities for the children of migrant workers and their parents. We also provide training on healthcare and childcare as well as a range of other services for migrant workers’ families.



### “Scholarship Project”

We sponsor the education of needy children of migrant families who, because of difficult financial circumstances, are on the verge of or are already not attending school. We help those needy children return to the classroom.



### “Build Partnerships”

To implement the vision of You Dao, we need to build effective partnerships. These include partnerships with companies, international schools, local communities and with individual people, either local or foreign. You Dao emphasizes the need to form a strong network of cooperation between groups and individuals because the extensive and diverse network of partners will make our work more effective.



### “Home Visit”

Our trained social workers visit families in their homes and assist the scholarship family to improve their living standards. We help them according to their need in order that they may participate more broadly into society.
